The Yackandandah Community Centre (YCC) – Community Grants program is part of the Yackandandah community op-shop social enterprise. Annual profits made by the community op-shop are distributed back into the community via the community grants program.

Grant Guidelines

YCC prioritise projects which aim to create ongoing benefits to Yackandandah, build community capacity and create positive change for the Yackandandah Community.

YCC is offering grant funding to local community groups up to a maximum value of *\$3,000*.

Application requirements

- YCC will only accept *one* application per organisation per year.
- If your project involves more than one organisation than, you must nominate one organisation that will manage the project and accept the grant funding on behalf of the project group.
- Grant funding will not be awarded to individuals, you must be in collaboration with a local community group or organisation.
- We can provide seed funding for projects that build capacity and help create structural change and have the potential to continue after the funding period.
- Grant funding amounts will be decided by the YCC Management Committee based on eligibility criteria.
- Full requested amount is not guaranteed. Fund allocation will depend on the amount available for grants and the number of applications and amounts requested.

Eligibility

To be eligible for a community grant, you must demonstrate through your application that your project will show one or more of the following criteria;

- Make a significant contribution to the Yackandandah Community
- Create opportunities for innovation and new ways of doing things
- Encourage inclusion and provide equal opportunities for all
- Enhance community self-resilience, including equipment
- Improve community well-being
- Offer learning opportunities
- Initiatives based on current climate science

Ineligibility

The Yackandandah Community Centre does not fund;

- Projects that do not meet the grant aim and eligibility of the YCC grants program
- The core operating costs of existing organisations
- Vehicles
- Food parcels, crisis, or emergency response
- Deficit funding
- Projects that will rely on recurrent funding from YCC
- Other philanthropic foundations or individuals
